KNOWN CONTROLS: Because it's up to each club to declare Known Controls we may not have included any in this program. If you wish to enter Known Controls, which affect only the instrument's Next Possible calculations, check with the club then do so.

To enter a Known Control select KNOWN (CheckMate) or cont (ProComp), enter the mileage where the control is located, then enter a 2 or 3. The 2 or 3 represents the miles of free zone BEFORE a Known, so the correct value for each Known must be entered. Since all Knowns have 3 miles of free zone AFTER them, your instrument automatically uses 3 for it's calculations while in a

race.
